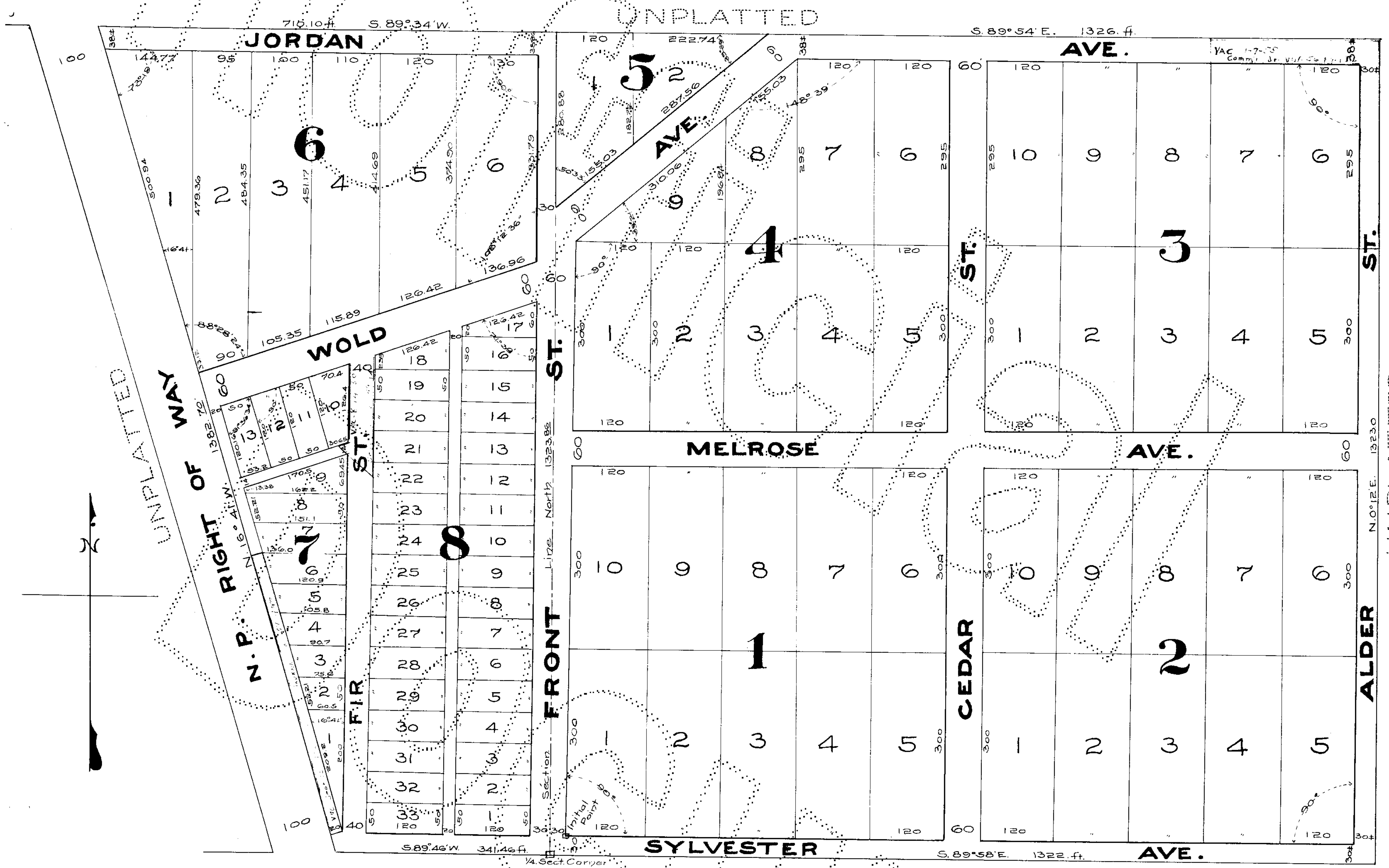

DESCRIPTION

This "Herbert S. Upper's First Addition to Issaquah" comprises the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of section 27 of township 24 N of range 6 E., W.M., and that portion of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of section 28 of said township and range, lying east of the right of way of the Seattle and International Railroad.

The Initial Point is the SW corner of lot 1 of block 1, which is 30 feet north and 30 feet east of the 1/4 section corner common to sections 27 and 28 of said township and range. The north and south streets are parallel to the west boundary line of said section 27.

DEDICATION

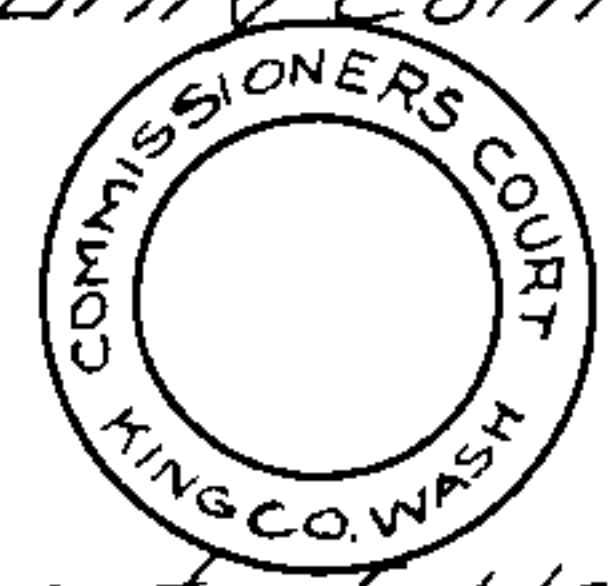

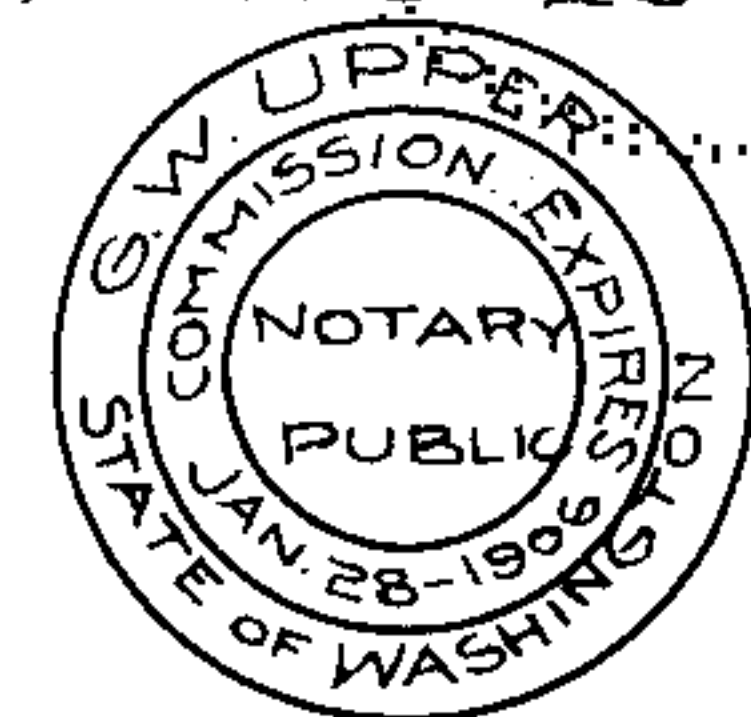
