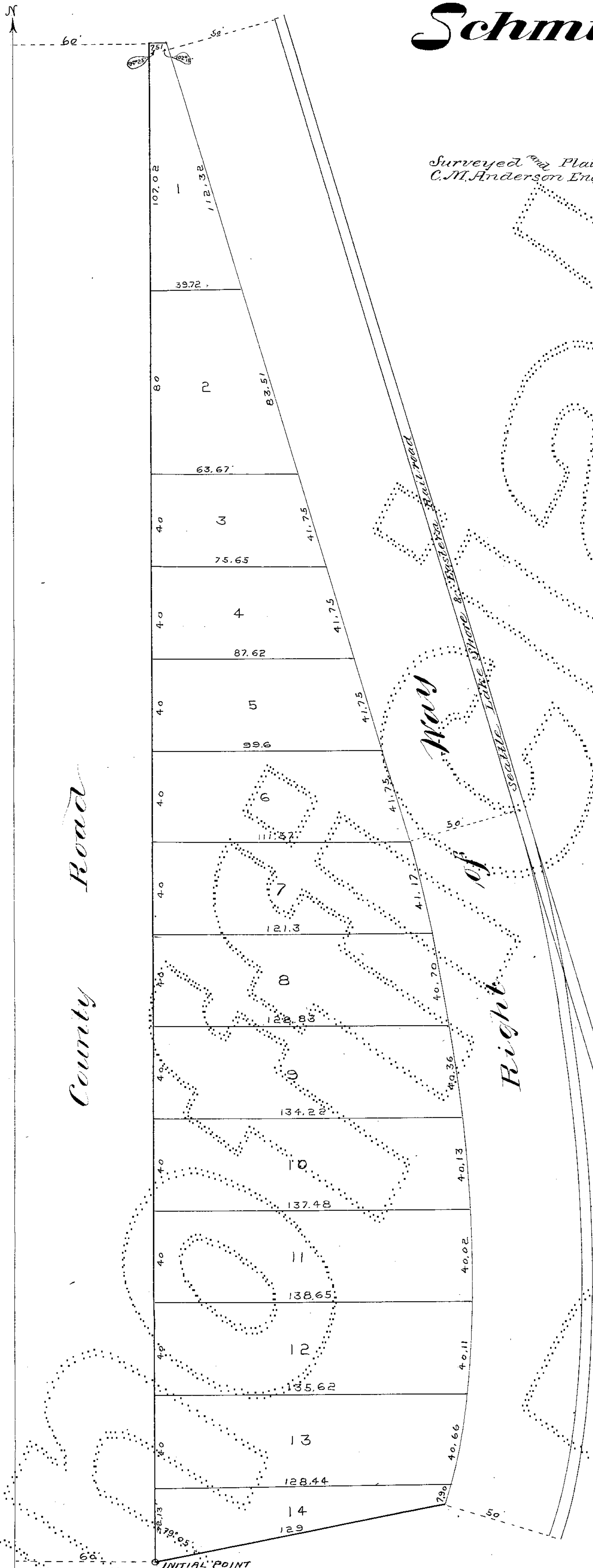


Schmidt's First Addition to GILMAN WASH.

Description

This Schmidt's First Addition to Gilman Wash. comprises all the following tract of land, lying and being in King County, State of Washington, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the East margin of the County road said point being 384.71 ft. North and 30 feet East of the corner to Sections 27, 28, 33 & 34 T₂₄ North, of Range 6 East N. W. and running thence North along the East marginal line of the County Road 659.15 ft. thence North 85°36' E. 721 ft. to the West line of the S. L. S. & E. Ry. right of way. Thence South along said West line of said right of way 653.88 ft. Thence South 79°05' West 129 feet to the point of beginning. The initial Point is the South West corner of lot 14 which is at the point of beginning in the above description all distances and angles are as shown upon the map in feet and degrees.
